Bartender



Bartenders serve people with beers, wines, colas and other types of drinks. They work in places like pubs, hotels and clubs, and at events like sports matches. In some bars they serve people with tea, coffee, snacks and meals. Bartenders take people's orders and get their drinks for them. They need to know about different drinks and how to serve them.

Door Attendant



Door Attendants stand at the doors of hotels and shops and greet people as they arrive. They also work at other smart places such as theatres. They are the first staff that people meet. Their job is to make visitors feel welcome.

Waiter



Waiters take orders for food and bring it to the table. They work in places such as restaurants, cafes, pubs and hotels. Men and women who do this job are called waiters. Women who do it may also be called waitresses.

Chef



Chefs prepare and cook food. They often work in places where people go to enjoy themselves such as restaurants and hotels. When they work in other places like hospitals and schools, they may be called cooks.
